Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.	<p>The Academic committee headed by the Director and the Academic Coordinator prepares a detailed semester –wise Annual Calendar for the entire Academic year, which efficiently deploys the units of time for academic and co-curricular purposes covering lectures, language lab, Excel class, tutorial, mentorship, summer internship project, ICT, life-skill, value education and add-on classes (master class). This ensures a balance between the different types of engagement a student is expected to participate in.</p> <p>The college is well equipped with smart class rooms, virtual class rooms, audio-visual and other ICT facilities which are extensively used by teachers in day to day teaching to make delivery of the curriculum attractive to students. Faculty members take utmost care to complete the syllabus in time. Tutorials/remedial/ projects, class tests and internal assessments comprise the formal evaluative processes, but students are encouraged to meet faculty beyond classroom for doubt-clearing and curricular discussions. Extra hours are devoted for taking remedial classes after completion of internal examinations to bolster students' preparedness before University Examinations. Periodic meetings of IQAC takes stock of the progress of teaching learning, among other things and meetings of the department with Director. Parent-teacher meetings and co-curricular are other forums where progress of the delivery of curriculum are regularly monitored and necessary course corrections are initiated. The institution has the language laboratory to enhance the communication skills of the students by using Orell Talk software.</p> <p>Interactive teaching is promoted through students' participation in group discussions, role play, quizzes and seminars. Special lectures delivered by eminent scholars on topics related to the curriculum further intensify students' learning experience. SRBS also fosters a research culture in the management students and as a result the students have won accolades in national and international conferences such as Avishkar and Prakash.</p> <p>The institution also believes that a student can observe, analyze and gain insight into various intricate aspects of their syllabus; much attention is paid to experiential learning like industrial visits to NSE, BSE, through intra and intercollegiate national quiz contests, EDC activity, IIC events such as panel discussion and seminars by the corporate conglomerates and leaders.</p>
