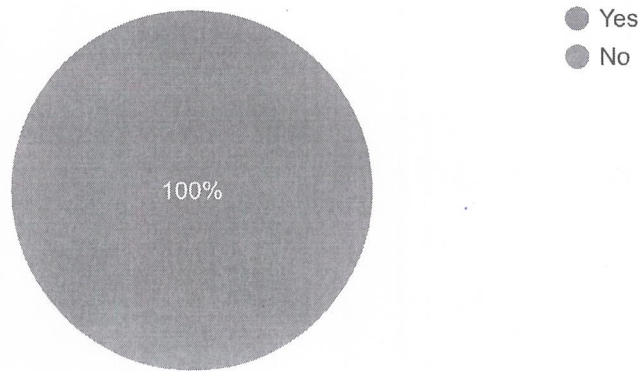

A survey of SRBS student satisfaction was conducted during AY 2021-22. The survey was implemented online with questionnaire recommended by NAAC. The results of the survey are as follows:

A survey of SRBS student satisfaction was conducted during AY 2021-22. The survey was implemented online with questionnaire recommended by NAAC. The results of the survey are as follows:
