Objectives-

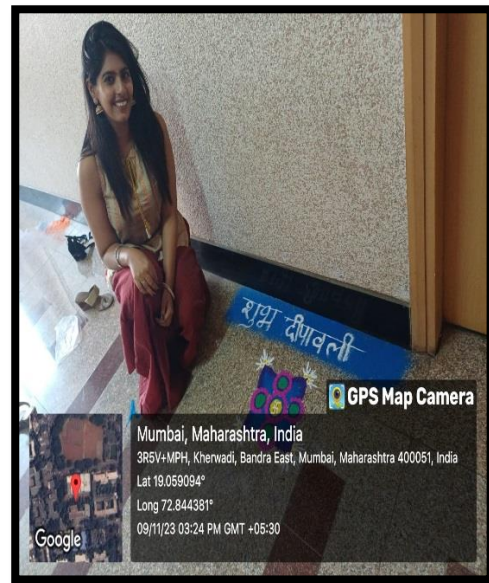
1. Students will be set by a spiritual quotient for the event and provided a moment for reflection and gratitude.
