Dr. Rahul Sanghavi read the Minutes of last IQAC meeting and Action Taken Report of the meeting held on May 07, 2022. The members found them in accordance with the last minutes of meeting held on **Saturday, May 07, 2022**.

Dr. Rahul Sanghavi presented the existing Organogram of SRBS wherein the Academic and Admin Committee is shown above the Director's level. It was an error by the then IQAC Coordinator which has been corrected and decided to continue the functioning of the Institute as per the original Organogram.

Agenda No. 3: To discuss the academic performances of previous semester results.

The Director asked Dr. Rahul Sanghavi to elaborate on the examination performance of PG programs. Dr. Rahul Sanghavi presented the result analysis of the MMS (Batch 2021-23) Semester-I examination held in April 2022. He highlighted that 94.73 % of students from the batch secured above First Class. Prof. Pradeep Singh presented the result analysis of BMS Course Semester II, IV & VI and for BAMMC Course Semester IV & VI for Summer 2021-2022. The members of the IQAC Committee expressed satisfaction about the student's results.

Prof. Darshana Murkibhavi, briefed the committee about the performance of the Training and Placement Cell (Executive and Summer Internship) for the Academic Year 2021-2022.

The committee members suggested to intimate the Faculty members asking them to publish minimum 02 papers in highly reputed journals in every academic year.

TAKEN REPORT OF 4th IQAC MEETING HELD ON
MAY 07, 2022, ACADEMIC YEAR 2021-22

The following actions have been initiated with respect to the Agenda of the 4th IQAC meeting held on **May 07, 2022**, (A.Y. 2021-22).

Agenda No. 3: To discuss the performance of students in examinations of UG and PG program.

The Director directed Prof. Sandeep Kudtarkar to elaborate on the examination performance of UG and PG programs. Prof. Sandeep Kudatarkar briefed the committee about the examination performance as per the following points:-

- The midterms of MMS program took place in hybrid mode as per Government norms.
- The final end semester examination of MMS 1st year took place in offline mode. This exam was a written examination for duration of 3 hours.
- It was observed that the students are not used to writing examination as exams were held in online mode through MCQ due to pandemic. As per the guidelines issued by University of Mumbai, it was decided to give additional 15 min/hour for the written examination.
- The Batch 2020-22 has been termed as "Covid Batch" hence, the end semester examination of this batch took place in offline mode in order to make them "Industry Acceptable".
- License of Online examination software was renewed for the smooth conduct of the exam with adequate proctoring provisions.
- Special consideration was given to the students residing in remote areas who were unable to take Offline Exams due to PG Accommodation & other issues.

Resolution No. 2: "Be it and it is hereby, **RESOLVED THAT** the examination department should continue working in accordance with University of Mumbai norms especially for a Covid Batch during Pandemic Period."





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The examination cell worked strictly in accordance with the University of Mumbai norms for conduct of Online examinations of Covid batch during the pandemic period.

Agenda No. 4: To review the progress of training and placement department.

- The Director briefed the committee about the performance of the training and placement department (Executive and Summer Internship) for the Academic Year 2021-2022.
- Every week placement status is reported to Hon. Gen. Secretary by Placement Cell since January, 2022.
- Till Date, 96 out of 133 Students of Batch 2021-23 are placed for Summer Internship & 61 out of 85 Students of Batch 2020-22 are placed in Executive placement.

The IQAC Coordinator read the minutes of the last IQAC meeting held on Thursday April 13, 2023. The members found them in accordance with the last minutes of the meeting.

Prof. Pradeep Singh informed the members about BMS Semester–V (Batch 2020-2023) & BAMMC Semester–V (Batch 2020-2023) Semester End Examinations of the University Papers were held last year during November/ December 2022. The results got delayed and declared on 13th April, 2023 & 24th April, 2023 respectively by the University of Mumbai.

He also informed that BMS Semester– II (Batch 2022-2025) & Semester–IV (Batch 2021-2024) Semester End Examinations at the Institute level on behalf of University of Mumbai was successfully completed during April 2023 and got over on 21st April, 2023.
