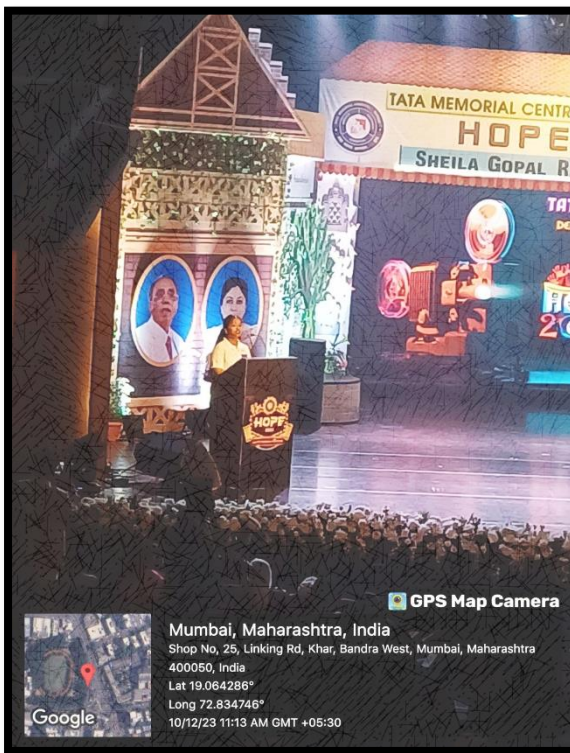
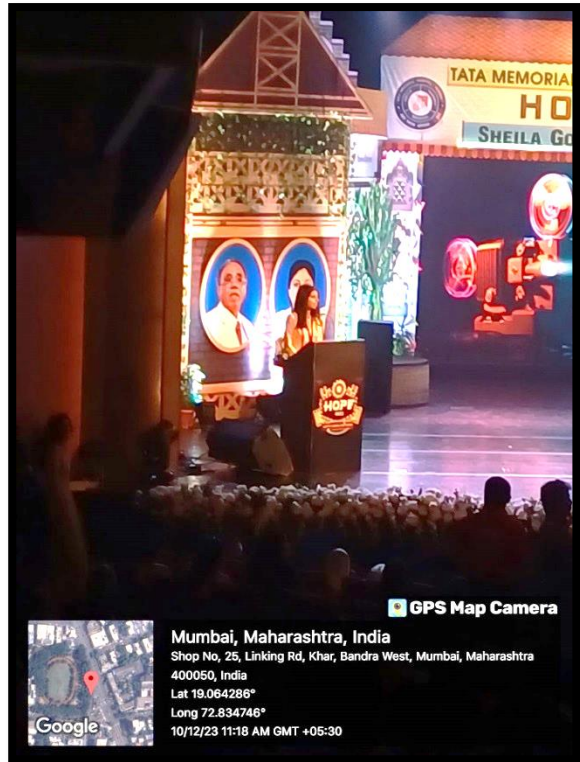
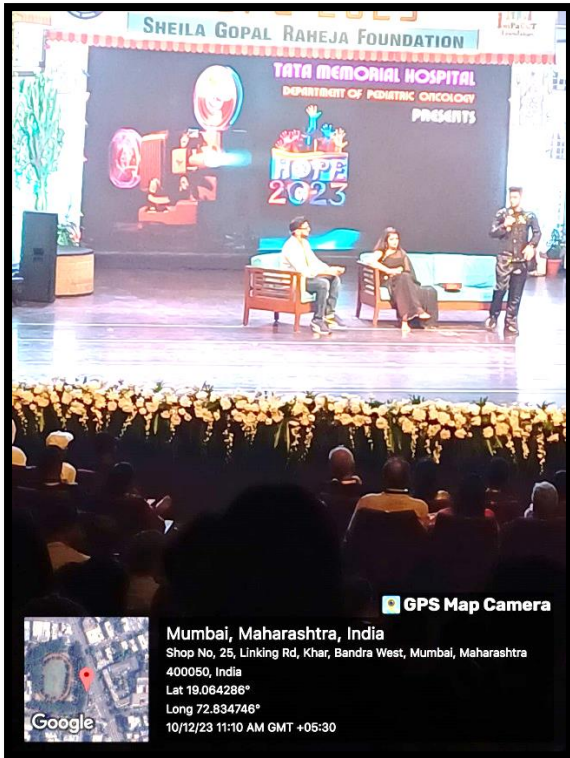
Objectives:

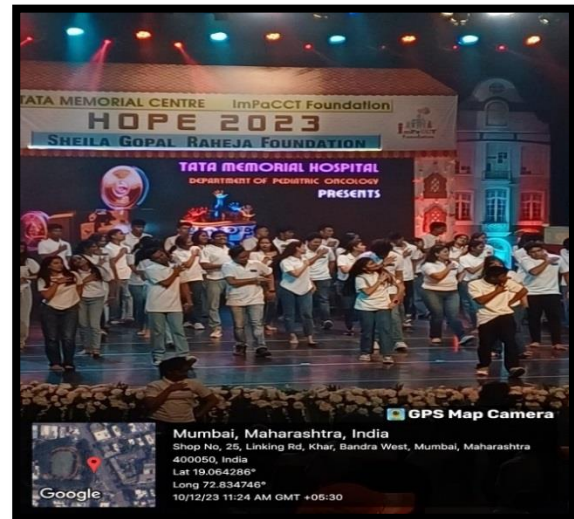
- To educate students about cancer awareness and prevention strategies.
