Learning Outcomes

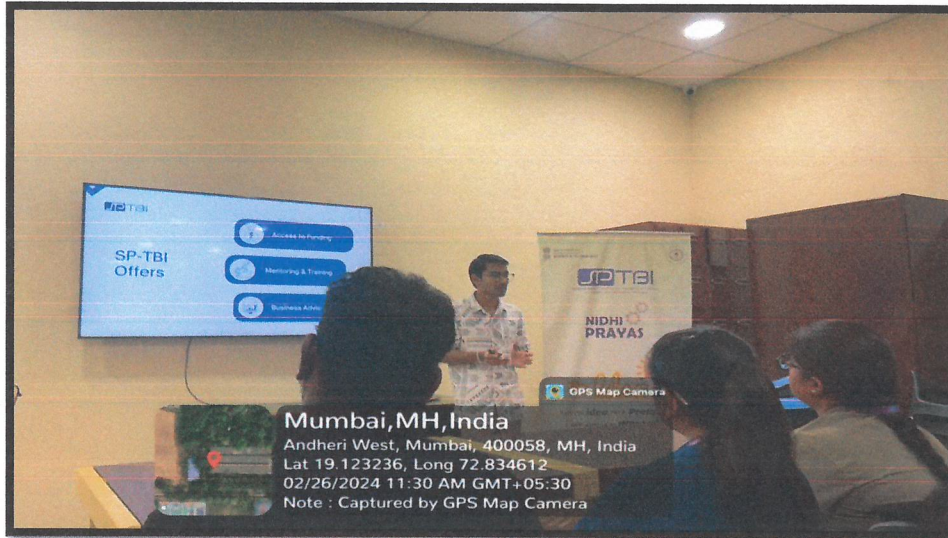
- Students gained a comprehensive understanding of the startup ecosystem, including the role of incubators in fostering entrepreneurship, providing support services to the start ups.
