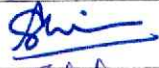
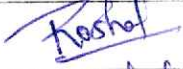

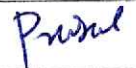

- To equip participants with knowledge and resources to assert their rights effectively, including how to file complaints, seek compensation, and access alternative dispute resolution mechanisms.

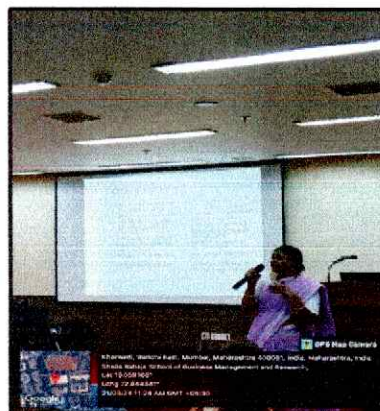
Learning Outcomes:
