DO's and DON'Ts for Blood Donation

Blood Donation General Requirements:

- Age: 18 to 60 years (up to 65 years if donating regularly)
- Weight: 45 kgs or More
- Hemoglobin at least 12.5 gm/dl

Precautions before donation:

- Should have eaten something within 4 hours prior to donation.
- Should have slept well for at least 6 hours continuously, within 24 hours before donation.
- Should not have smoked within 4 hours prior to donation.
- Should not have consumed alcohol within 24 hours prior to donation.
- Should not have undergone tattooing or body piercing within 12 months.
- Do not wear clothes with tight sleeves on the arm.
- Should not have taken aspirin in the last 3 days.
- Should not have taken antibiotics in the last 2 weeks.
- Donors taking oral anti-diabetic drugs, can be accepted if their blood sugar levels are within normal range and the medicine dose was unchanged in the last 4 weeks or taking insulin cannot go for blood donation.
- Donors taking oral anti-hypertensive drugs, can be accepted if their blood pressure levels are within normal range.

Post-donation care:

- Take more fluids orally than usual in next 48 hours like fruit juices, water, etc.
- Avoid smoking for 30 minutes after donation.
- Do not stand in direct sunlight for long.
- Avoid alcohol for next 24 hours.
- Avoid any heavy strenuous activity for that day like jogging, gym workouts, swimming, etc.
- If there is bleeding from phlebotomy site, raise arm for 3-5 min and apply pressure at the site with cotton gauze.
- Remove bandage 5-6 hours after donation.
- If there is feeling of giddiness, either lie down or sit with head between the knees, take slow and long deep breaths.
- If the symptoms persist, call for help or return to blood centre and consult the doctor.

Additional points in COVID situation:

- Donors need to wear a mask properly covering the nose and mouth from the time they enter the 'Camp Site' to the time they exit, except when they are having refreshments.
- Donors need to use hand sanitizer available at the entrance of the 'Camp Site'.
- They should follow proper physical distancing norms for their and others safety.
- Avoid 'Camp Site' visit if your family members or colleagues with whom you share work place had cough, cold or fever in the past 1 month.
- Avoid 'Camp Site' visit if you or your family member were admitted or under home isolation in past 28 days
- One is eligible to donate blood 14 days after COVID vaccination.

Blood Donation Information**

Blood donation is a process by which a blood donor voluntarily donates his/her blood for storage in a blood centre for subsequent use in a patient for transfusion.

Registration

The process of donating blood involves filling up blood donation forms, screening of the donor, the donation procedure and a brief recovery period with refreshments. When a donor arrives at a donation site, the donor fills out a Blood Donation Form including consent and answering the questionnaire to help determine his/ her eligibility at the registration counter.

Donor Screening by Medical Officer

The blood hemoglobin concentration, donor's weight and overall screening is done by the medical officer to assess the donor's suitability for blood donation.

Blood Donation Procedure

After screening, the donor is guided to hydrate well with atleast 2 glasses of water before donation. The donor lies in a supine position on recliner and extends an arm. A tourniquet is wrapped around his/ her arm or may be prompted to squeeze a ball, to help make the vein prominent. Blood flows from the vein, through the needle and a tube, and into a blood collection bag which is placed on a blood collection monitor to measure the amount of blood withdrawn. Typically, around 350-450 milliliters of blood (i.e. a one pint) is drawn during the blood donation process as per donor's body weight.

Recovery and Refreshments

Once the donation is complete, the donor is made to rest for few minutes and offered light refreshment and a spot bandage is applied to the arm to stop further blood flow. Pressure should be applied at the phlebotomy site for 5 – 10 minutes to prevent bruising.

- If there is bleeding from phlebotomy site, raise the arm and apply pressure.
- If there is feeling of faintness or dizziness, either lie down or sit with head between knees. If symptoms persist, ask for help, return to blood centre or consult a doctor
- Remove the bandage after 5 to 6 hours.

Donors are discouraged from doing heavy exercise or lifting weights until the next day. Plasma volumes will return to normal in around 24 hours, while red blood cells are replaced by bone marrow into the circulatory system within about 3-5 weeks, and lost iron is replaced over 6-8 weeks.

Appreciation:

Donors are given appreciation certificate by the blood centre.

Frequently Asked Questions

- 1) What fluids should I take after donation of blood?
Water, Fruit juices, Milk, Health drinks etc.
- 2) Is there any special diet that I need to take after donation?
Have a balanced, nutritious diet rich in iron and minerals
- 3) Do I need to take rest for a day?
You can carry out your normal, routine, non-strenuous activities. However, if you have experienced some reaction after blood donation, then avoid long journeys or driving a vehicle and rest for a day.
- 4) Can I do strenuous exercises or lift weights after a donation?
No. Refrain from strenuous activity for 1 day.
- 5) When can I donate blood again?
For male blood donor there should be a gap of 3 months between two blood donations.
For female donor there should be a gap of atleast 4 months between two blood donations.
- 6) What should I do if my hand pains after donation?
A small bandage will be applied to the arm from where blood was donated. Apply ice if it pains few hours later. The management includes:
R - Rest
I - Ice (wrapped in a cloth)
C - Compression
E - Elevation
And
Tab. Paracetamol after Medical advice

Contact Blood Centre doctor for details

- You may donate blood if your age is between 18 to 65 years and your weight is above 45 kgs. First time donor shall not be over 60 years of age.
- Do eat and drink water immediately prior to donation
- Do have proper sleep in the night prior to donation day
- Do provide us honest and uninhibited disclosure of medical history
