

On Sunday, 23rd February 2025, the students of Sheila Raheja School of Business Management and Research along with 6 faculty members and 3 representatives from the tour operator left for the much-awaited study tour to Amritsar- Kullu- Manali. The departure for Amritsar by 12903 Golden Temple Express happened from Mumbai Central at 18.45 hrs and after almost 36hrs journey, the group arrived in the holy city of Amritsar.

The succeeding morning after breakfast, the team proceeded to National Rubber Corporation (NRC) and Verka Dairy as they were a part of the industrial exposure itinerary. The students got an opportunity to witness the manufacturing setup and the processing that happens on respective raw materials to convert them into finished goods.

After visiting various industries, the students had a quick lunch and then headed to the Wagah-Attari border and the Golden Temple—two iconic places that beautifully represent Indian culture, national pride, and spiritual heritage.

The atmosphere at the Wagah-Attari border was charged with enthusiastic patriotism. Behind the stadium stood a towering pole bearing the Indian tricolour, and as the flag was hoisted, it filled every Indian present with immense pride and love for the nation. After attending the retreat ceremony and witnessing the solemn yet stirring moment of the lowering of the flags, the group proceeded to the revered Harmandir Sahib, also known as the Golden Temple, in Amritsar. Steeped in history and spirituality, the Golden Temple is a shining symbol of equality, humility, and universal brotherhood. There, everyone offered prayers, sought the blessings of Guru Nanak Dev Ji, and admired the breathtaking sight of the golden dome reflecting in the serene waters of the Amrit Sarovar under the night sky. The peaceful ambiance, divine hymns, and warm hospitality at the langar (community kitchen) offered students a lived experience of the Indian Knowledge System in action emphasizing values such as community service, inclusivity, and inner peace.


B) Gender split










