5. To raise awareness among students for the preservation and promotion of Hindi as a language.

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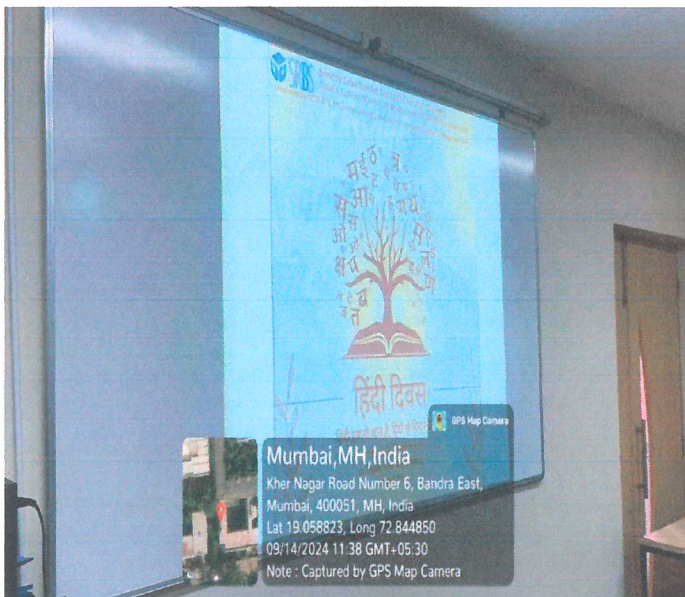


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Outcomes of the event to students:-
