Agenda No. 1: To read and approve the last minutes of meeting held on April 12, 2025.

The minutes of last Anti-Ragging Committee meeting held on April 12, 2025 were read before the members. After thorough discussions, the minutes were confirmed and approved.

Action to be taken: Approved minutes to be signed by all the members.



Agenda No. 2: To discuss the Anti-Ragging cases received (if any) after the last meeting.

All the members were apprised that SRBS has not received any Ragging cases from any of the stakeholders. The Director of the Institution appreciated the fact that there have been no grievances related to Ragging.

Agenda No. 3: To re-constitute existing Anti-Ragging Committee.

All the Members present were apprised of the formation of new College Anti-Ragging Committee with an addition of two new students one from MMS Batch 2025 - 2027 & one from B.Com. (Management Studies) Batch 2025 - 2028 and a parent of the student of First Year MMS Batch 2025 - 2027. All the Committee Members were informed to maintain vigil, oversight and patrolling functions and shall remain mobile alert and active at all times.

The updated list of members of Anti-Ragging Committee shall be displayed in the campus on the notice board and on website of the Institute.

Action to be taken: Display list of members of Anti-Ragging Committee in the campus and to update it on the Website of the Institute.

Agenda No. 4: To apprise the members about creating awareness among the students on ragging.

During the Induction Programs of the Batch 2025-2027 for MMS Students and Batch 2025-2028 for B.Com. (Management Studies) Students an awareness program was organized wherein students were briefed on prevention of Ragging on Campus and consequences of Ragging that will affect their career.

Further, the Director instructed the students that the students should desist themselves from any act of Ragging. However, if any instances conducted or faced by the students should be immediately reported to the Anti-Ragging Committee on the helpline number that is displayed in the campus.

Agenda No. 5: To apprise the Committee member about the circular issued by AICTE for implementation of AICTE Anti-Ragging Regulations, 2009.

All the members were updated that AICTE has issued Circular No. F.No.25-AICTE/AR/Antiragging/2025 dated May 13, 2025 wherein they have highlighted that due to growing incidents of ragging in the Higher Educational Institutions they have asked all the educational

institution to ensure implementations of University Grants Commissions (UGC) Regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in Higher Education Institutions.

They have listed the measures to be implemented/adopted for prevention, prohibition and awareness about ragging and its consequences.

Further, they have reminded all the institution to ensure that no incident of ragging occurs within the premises and the effective monitoring systems, awareness, initiatives and redressal mechanisms are in place to address any complaint promptly.

Further, they have also pointed out that failure to comply with the measures as prescribed under AICTE, Anti-Ragging Regulations, 2009 shall attract punitive action against the non-compliance institutions as per Approval Process Handbook /Regulations.

Agenda No. 6: To apprise the Committee members about the circular issued by Department of Students' Development of University of Mumbai.

All the members were informed about the contents of the Circular No. SW/08/of 2025 dated July 16, 2025 issued by Department of Students' Development of University of Mumbai wherein they have given reference of Letter No. D.O.No.F.1-15/2009 (ARC) Pt.III dated June 10, 2025 issued by University Grants Commission (UGC) wherein they have mentioned about multiple mechanism, recommendations and active steps that are needed to be taken to ensure ragging free environment in the institutes.

Action to be taken: "To ensure that the College implements all the mechanism and recommendation as per the regulations."

Agenda No. 7: Any other matter with the permission of the Chair.

The Director appreciated the Committee being active. Since no cases of Ragging within the campus were reported there were no further discussions and the meeting ended with a vote of thanks.
