In order to implement the same, SRBS had already constituted the Institution Innovation Council. This Council now stands reconstituted with the following members with immediate effect.

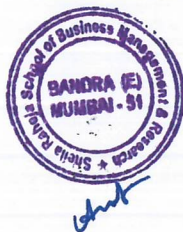
