18th January 2026 & 19th January 2026 – Journey & Udaipur Visit:

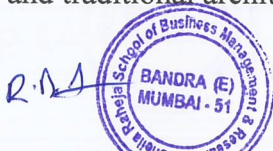

Interaction with engineers and managers provided valuable insights into production planning, workflow management, and industrial quality standards. The visit effectively connected theoretical concepts of operations and production management with real-world industrial practices.

The group also visited Adalaj Stepwell, an architectural marvel, followed by a visit to Sabarmati Ashram, associated with Mahatma Gandhi. A walk along the Sabarmati Riverfront concluded the day.

On the night of 23rd January 2026, students departed by train, marking the conclusion of the industrial study tour, and safely reached Mumbai on 24th January 2026.
